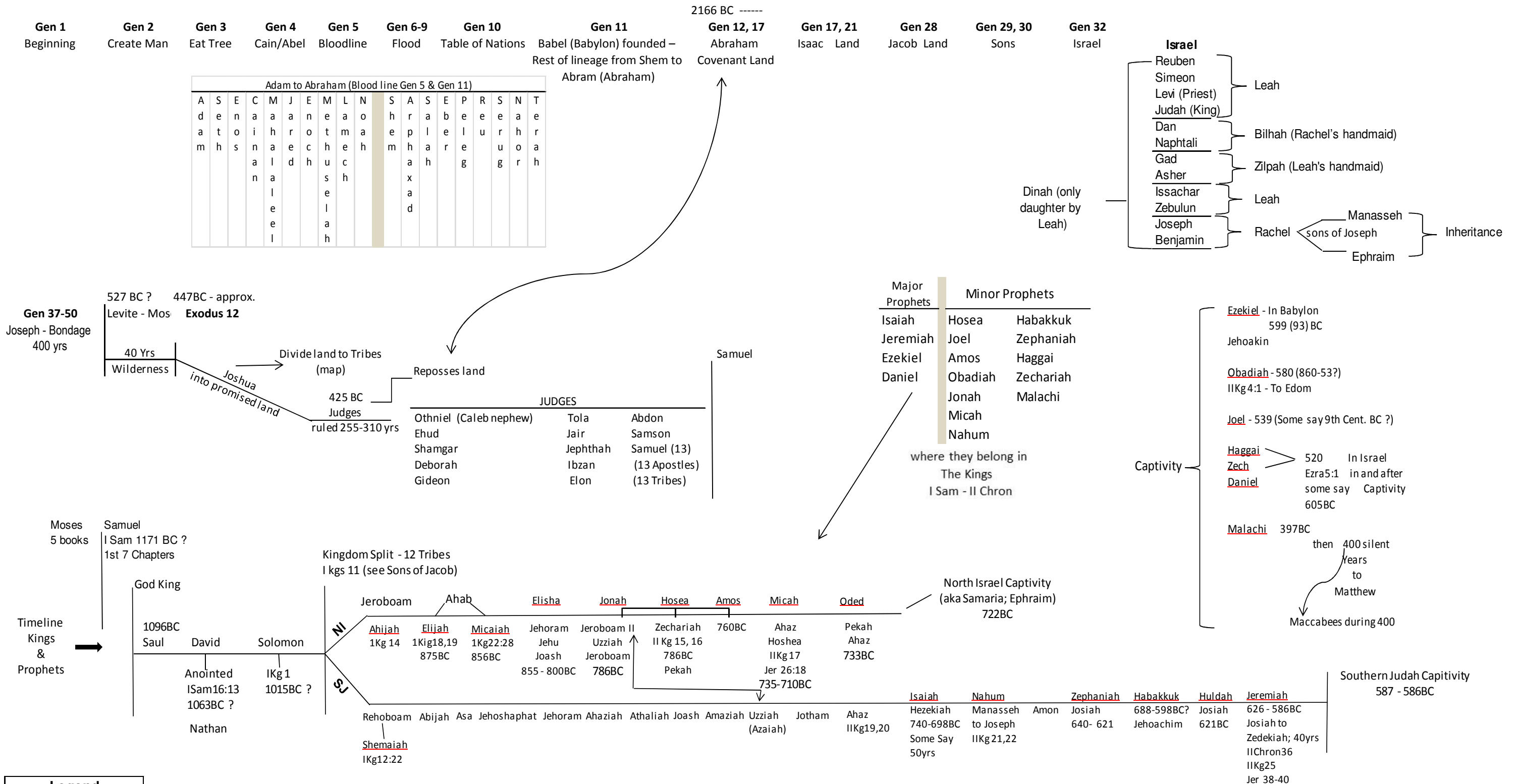


A Picture Time Line of The Old Testament (in a nutshell) in its entirety (you fill in the events and characters)
