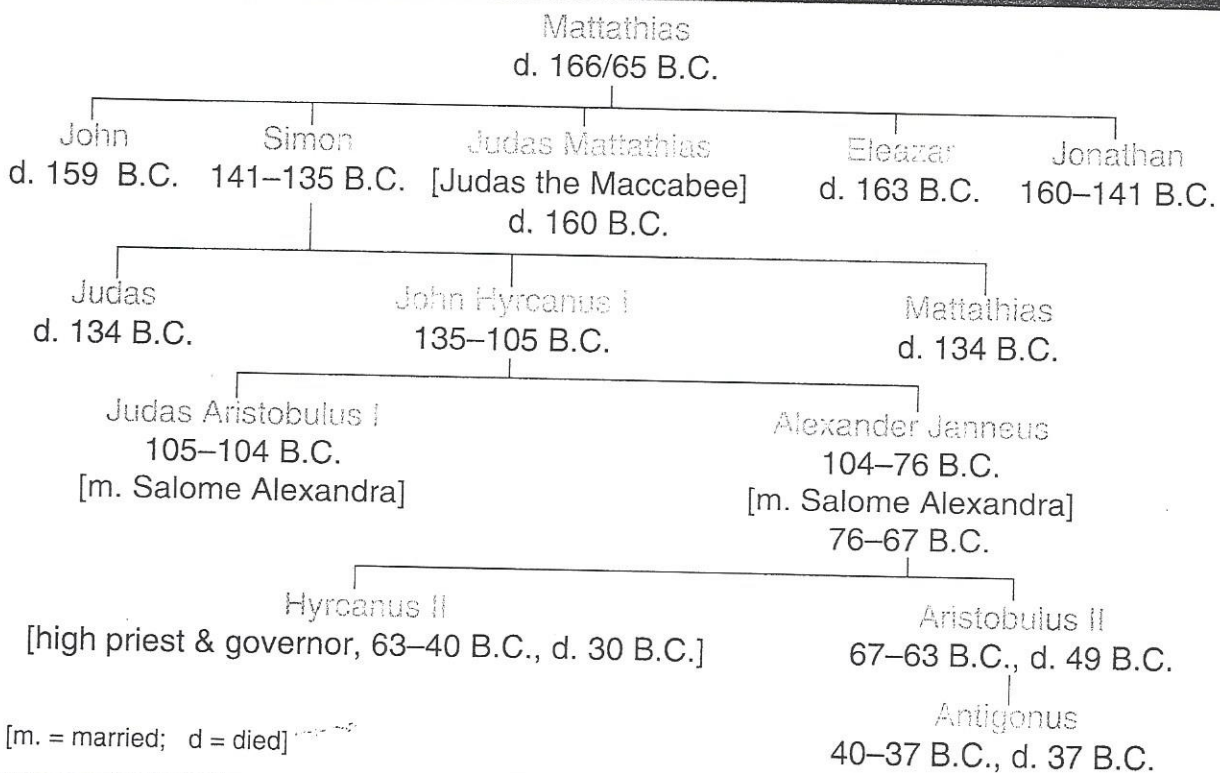


THE HASMONEAN DYNASTY

Herod I (the Great)	Son of Antipater	King of Judea	37–4 B.C.	Matt 2:1-22; Luke 1:5
Herod Archelaus	Oldest son of Herod the Great	Ethnarch of Judea, Samaria, and Idumea	4 B.C.–A.D. 6	Matt 2:22
Herod Philip*	Son of Herod the Great and Cleopatra of Jerusalem	Tetrarch of Iturea and Trachonitis	4 B.C.–A.D. 34	Luke 3:1
Herod Antipas	Youngest son of Herod the Great Second husband of Herodias	Tetrarch of Galilee and Perea	4 B.C.–A.D. 39	Matt 14:1-11; Mark 6:14-29; Luke 3:1, 19; 13:31-33; 23:7-12
Herod Agrippa I	Grandson of Herod the Great	King of Judea	A.D. 37–44	Acts 12
Herod Agrippa II	Great-grandson of Herod the Great	Tetrarch and king of Chalcis	A.D. 44–100 (Became king in A.D. 48)	Acts 25:13–26:32

* Another Herod Philip is mentioned in the New Testament. He is the son of Herod the Great and Mariamne II and was the first husband of Herodias. (See Matt 14:3; Mark 6:17; and Luke 3:19.)
