## Segments of Scripture Aug 13, 03

### Chastisement, The Rod, and Children

Prov. 3: 11,12 who The Lord loveth he correcteth

Prov. 10:13 rod is for the back void of understanding

Prov. 13:24 he that spareth his rod hateth his son

Prov. 22: 6,8,15 (Train - chanak - To narrow, initiate, discipline)

Prov. 23:13,14 if thou beat him with the rod he shall not die

Prov. 19:18 chasten thy son let not thy soul spare for his crying

Prov. 26:3 a rod is for the fool's back

Prov. 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom

Lam 3:1 a man that hath seen affliction by the rod of his wrath

Deut. 8:5 as a man chasteneth his son, so the Lord chasteneth thee

Job 33:19 he is chastened with pain upon his bed

Heb 12: 6-11 whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth and scourgeth

Psalms 89:30-36 I will visit their transgression with the rod

Job 5:17 happy is the man whom God correcteth

Deut. 21:18-21 a rebellious son -- the men shall stone him

Psalms 110: The Lord hath chastened me but has not killed me

II Sam 7:14 IF he (David) commit iniquity I will chasten him with the rod

Psalms 6:1,2 rebuke me not in thine anger nor chasten in hot displeasure

Lev. 26: 18, 21, 24, 28 I will punish and chasten thee 7 times

Hos 7:12 I will chastise them (Ephraim)

Job 9:34 Let him take his rod away from me

Job 21:7-9 neither is the rod of God upon them (of the wicked)

Psalms 110:2 The Lord shall send the rod of thy strength

Isa 10:5, 24-27 O ASSYRIAN, the rod of mine anger

Isa 11:1-4; 30:31 - Micah 6:9 - John 15:2 I Cor 11:32

## Children

Eph 6:4 paideia - tutorage, education, TRAINING

disciplinary correction, chastening, chastisement, instruction, (see Luke 14:27)

paideuo - to train up (chasten) a child educate, discipling (by punishment) chasten; chaste, instruct (teach, learn)

pais - a boy as often beaten with impunity (without punishment), a girl, a child, a slave, or servant - minister to a King (Agape, diaconos, huperetes)

by eminence to God; a child, maid, servant, young man

paio - to hit as if by a single blow, a sting as a scorpion, strike, smite

paideutes - Trainer, teacher, discipliner.

paidagogos - from pais and ago, a boy leader a servant whose office it was to take the children to school, a tutor, a paedagogue

Gal 3:24, 25

paidarion - a little boy, child, lad

paidiothen - from infancy of a child

paidion - a childling (of either sex), infant, half grown boy or girl fig. immature Christian

paidiske - a girl female slave or servant

paizo - to sport or play as a boy
